

Regulations and Rules 12th Brixen Dolomiten Marathon Saturday, 2nd July 2022 Relays:



4x4: 11 km - 8 km - 14,5 km - 8,5 km 2x2: 19 km - 23 km

Preamble: In these regulations and rules the masculine form is used to designate male and female genders.

<u>COVID-19:</u> the current Covid-19 regulations, which will be communicated in good time, apply on the day of the event.

Route: height difference up 2.450 m – down 2.450 m, distance 42,195 km, time limit: 8 hours. Flat running in part from Brixen to Milland (asphalt road), incline over Mellaun to St. Andrä/valley station of cable car (hiking and forest trail) – 1^{st} changing station 4x4 (1.060 m). Further on towards Afers (1.500 m) – 2^{nd} change 4x4, unique for the relay 2x2. The route leads partly on hiking and forest trails and asphalt road to Rossalm Hut (2.200 m) over to Kreuztal/summit station of cable car (2.050 m) – 3^{rd} change 4x4. Hiking trail to Ochsenalm (2.080 m) and final ramp to the plateau at the Plose (2.450 m).

IMPORTANT: if an athlete **does not** reach Kreuztal within 1.30 pm, he will be taken out of the race by removing the chip. The athlete can finish the race at his own responsibility, but without the starting number.

Participation permission

- Participants must be at least 16 years old on 2nd July 2022.
- ➤ Foreign participants must present a Certificate of Health, valid on 2nd July 2022 (download at the homepage). You have to send this certificate until 29th of June 2022 at the mail address info@brixenmarathon.it

Only well-trained runners can handle this alpine challenge. By signing the registration form the runner accepts the rules of this marathon as well as the regulations of the IAAF. For all regulations not mentioned in this invitation the international regulations of CONI and ICMR are applied.

<u>Registration:</u> The registration takes place online at <u>www.brixenmarathon.com</u> (link Datasport) and it is only valid after payment of the registration fee. Participants who register within 31.05.2022 will receive a personalized starting number.

Registration deadline: Wednesday, 29th July 2022, 7 p. m.

From 1st July 2022 registrations will only be possible on site at the Cathedral Square in Brixen from 1 to 7 p.m.

Registration change/cancellation: The re-registration of a purchased starting place must be made by 29.06.2022. A processing fee of € 5 will be charged for this. Changes of any kind are also only possible until 29.06.2022. Those who have taken out insurance will be reimbursed the entry fee by the insurance company. Information on this can be obtained from the timekeeping company Datasport at info@datasport.com. The registration fee will not be refunded by the organizer and will not be credited for the following year.

Categories

Relay 4x4: W/M/Mixed. The first three of each category will be awarded. Relay 2x2: W/M/Mixed. The first three of each category will be awarded.

<u>Distribution of start numbers:</u> Friday from 1 to 7 p.m. and Saturday from 6 to 7 a.m. Cathedral Square Brixen. <u>ATTENTION:</u> The race numbers will only be handed over together, upon presentation of a valid identification document. The race number must be fully visible during the race, may not be removed and is not transferable. Start: Saturday, 8 a.m. Cathedral Square Brixen.

<u>Luggage transport:</u> ONLY to finish area (Plose) should be handed over at starting area on Saturday from 6.30 to 7.30 a.m. Only one piece of luggage per athlete with a maximum weight of 10 kg will be transported.

<u>Athlete transport to changing areas:</u> own athlete buses bring the relay runners from Regensburger Allee 9 in Brixen to the changing areas on indicated times in the welcome bag.

Athlete transport from finish area (Plose) to Brixen

- From the finish area to Kreuztal: NO transport (footpath about 25 minutes).
- From Kreuztal to St. Andrä: the race number is valid as a ticket for the cable car.
- ➤ From St. Andrä to Brixen (bus station): own athlete buses (free), as well as public buses (about € 2).

<u>Pasta Party:</u> Friday from 1 p.m., Saturday from 1 to 6 p.m. Cathedral Square Brixen (1 voucher is on the race number).

Services: the registration fee includes the following services:

- Medal
- Lending fee for the time measuring chip (transponder)
- Bus to the changing areas 1 and 2
- Pasta Party at the Cathedral Square Brixen
- Welcome Bag with several products
- Route catering: adapted to the current Covid-19 regulations
- Luggage transport to the finish
- Race day: the race number is valid as ticket for the cable car St. Andrä/Kreuztal/St. Andrä and for the transport from St. Andrä to Brixen (bus station) on indicated times in your welcome bag.

<u>Chip:</u> the chip can be attached to the wrist or ankle and must be handed over to the next relay runner in the respective changing areas. The final runner must return it in the finish area and will receive all 4 or 2 relay medals there. If lost, a fee of € 35 will be charged.

Prize giving ceremony: at the Cathedral Square Brixen at 6 p.m. (the prices will not be delivered).

Within one hour after the finish, there is the possibility to lodge a protest at the Info-Point at the Cathedral Square in case of rule violations of other participants or against decisions of the race control. All witnesses named must appear. The protest fee is € 100. If the protest is lost, the fee remains with the organizer.

Parking

- Free parking at Brixen-Süd, Fischzuchtweg (1 km from the starting area).
- ≥ 24-hours-ticket (single exit) € 5, Parking garage, Dantestraße Brixen, can be bought in the starting area.

<u>Trail-Shoes:</u> the organizer reserves the right to require participants to use trail shoes in appropriate weather conditions. This will be checked before the start. Those runners who do not comply with this obligation will be disqualified by the technical race management - without entitlement to a credit of the entry fee.

<u>Route change/Race stop:</u> in case of bad weather or dangerous conditions the event organizer has the right to change to an alternative, also homologated track. Every athlete must follow the instructions of the volunteers and the rescue team. If the race is stopped, the registration fee will not be refunded.

<u>Cancellation of the race:</u> may be due to force majeure. The organizer decides if part of the registration fee will be refunded, or the registration will be credited for the next year.

<u>Health:</u> this race is an alpine challenge and is only suitable for highly-trained runners. We appeal to the own responsibility and the common sense of every participant. Every runner takes part of his own risk and responsibility. Doctors and duty along the route and the final runner ("sweeper bus") are authorized to retire a runner from the race on medical grounds. If a competitor continues the race against a medical directive or run

behind the official last control vehicle ("sweeper bus"), he does so at his own responsibility and without any entitlement to the marathon services.

Important

- The use of walking poles or other technical aid is not allowed. From Kreuztal (km 33,7) only the drought categories W/M 60+ are allowed to use nordic walking poles.
- > Self-catering, which is provided by third parties outside of the official refreshment points can lead to the disqualification of the athlete concerned.

Security: Volunteer fire brigades, mountain rescue service, paramedics, doctors.

How to get there

- > By car: Brenner motorway A22: from north exit Brixen/Vahrn, from south exit Klausen.
- By train: Brenner railway: station Brixen.
- > By plane: the closest airports are: Bozen (45 km), Innsbruck (85 km), Verona Villafranca (190 km).

<u>Disqualification:</u> doping, mechanical assistance from outside, use of vehicles, shortening/leaving the official route, waste disposal at unmarked places, failure to provide assistance, exchange of start numbers, non-compliance of route service instructions. The organizer reserves the right to punish further unsportsmanlike violations with disqualification. The principle of sportiness and fairness applies. Pay attention to traffic rules: roads to be crossed are not closed.

<u>Privacy:</u> By registering, every athlete approves the disclosure of his own sensitive data following the privacy rules. The participant agrees that these may be passed on to third parties for the purpose of time measurement, the creation and display of result lists and the setting of these lists on the website. In addition, the organizer is permitted to publish these data, photos, videos in all relevant media (website, print media, internet) is approved (DL. Nr. 196, art. 2003). I agree that the data specified in my registration, the photos and videos may be used without any right to compensation on my part. I know that it is forbidden to pass my personal number to another person without complying with the official transfer procedure. I also know that the official route cannot be left, I accept the orders of the track marshals.
